

COMMUNITY SERVICE WORK OPPORTUNITIES

Successful Participants will be placed at various schools within specific District Municipalities in the Limpopo region for a duration of 6 months where they will be engaged in the following paid Community Service activities:

- Landscaping

- Fence fixing
- Clearing of shrubs & grass
- General Building Maintenance
- Arts and Crafts
- Music

Participants will be engaged 16 hours per week, and they will receive a stipend of R23.19 per hour.

Eligibility Criteria:

1. Unemployed youth between the ages of 18 and 35 will be eligible.
2. Women and disabled persons within the same age groups will be eligible.
3. Applicant should have no contractual obligations towards other companies.
4. Applicant should have South African citizenship.
5. Applicant should have a valid SA bank account.
6. Applicant should be willing to work in a team for 16 hours a week of active Community Service.
7. Applicants must be residing in proximity of the project sites which are in the following municipalities: Mopani & Capricorn.
